SECTION 1: INDICATOR CODES FOR STATUS OF DUTY AND PERSONAL INFORMATION

1100. CHILD/DEPENDENT CUSTODY CODES. Changes or correction to single parent designator codes are entered into MCTFS with the below-listed codes. MCTFS will compare these codes with the Marital Status Codes in paragraph 1108 to ensure data accuracy and further delineation of the term single parent.
